Releases from Success had been decreased over the past week to repair flood damages. The biggest repairs have been made and releases have been slowly increased this week. Releases from Success are currently at 1300 cfs and will probably stay there for 30-45 days, until after the peak snow melt. Generally the peak snow melt from the Tule is in the first half of May. This being an extraordinary year, we may see it extend to later into May.

With the current level of releases, Lower Tule will now be in a more normal delivery operation. The water rates were considered at the April Board meeting. The **April and May rates were set at \$65 per acre-foot.** While the Board did not set the summer water rate, it is expected that those rates will be in the \$85-\$90 per acre-foot range.

As always orders must be placed by 9:00 am for next day delivery.
