Updates on the 2023 Lower Tule water run:

- Based on current forecasts, Uncontrolled Season releases from Millerton will end somewhere in the last week of July.
- The Success reservoir is nearing the max storage for this year of 75,000 acre-feet (due to the Success Reservoir Enlargement Project).
- At the Board meeting in July, it was determined that the District will have enough water supply remaining that we do not need to allocate water, at least for August. That means in August, growers can continue to utilize as much surface water as needed for both irrigation and recharge purposes.
- Next month the Board will determine whether there will be a need to allocate water for September and beyond.
- As a reminder, these are the types of years landowners can take advantage of by recharging water and building up their groundwater accounts.
