To: LANDOWNERS AND WATER USERS

March 15, 2001

Despite the recent storms and rainfall, 2001 is shaping up to be a below average water year. Current supply conditions will allow for approximately 60 days of water this summer. We are currently targeting a run that would begin toward the later part of May and continue through the first half of June. At that point conditions would be reassessed to determine the balance of the summer run, i.e., two weeks on/off if necessary. It should be noted that it is still to early to target an exact run, with the unpredictability of future weather events being the wild card in the game.

The current water rate of \$35 per acre-foot will remain in effect until further notice. It is the intention of the Board to keep the water rate as close to that of previous years as possible while still managing the rising cost that the District must pay for the water. We will keep you informed of any changes in the supply and/or rate. Please contact the District office for additional information.

A reminder that all water accounts and Reclamation Law forms must be current in order to receive water.
