**TO: ALL LANDOWNERS AND WATER USERS**

**GIVEN THE SUBSTANTIAL INCREASE IN WATER USE THERE WILL NOT BE A SPLIT RUN**

While we had hoped to have a short August run, the use during July (as much as 25% above average) dictates that we extend the current run until the balance is gone. After looking at the matter in detail, the Board of Directors decided that the most efficient use of the available water would be to extend the current run. Had we gone with the original plan the August run would have only lasted several days. By extending the current run rather than splitting the runs we are able to save a couple of days worth of water that is normally lost during start up and shutdown. It is estimated that water to all parts of the system will be available through July 26<sup>th</sup>. We will send out further notice as the picture becomes clearer. We apologize for any inconvenience this decision may have caused you.
